In both Spelling and Mathematics, we have professional learning teams of teachers who review student outcomes and plan for improvement. In Spelling we are very fortunate to be participating in an inquiry with Christine Topfer who is a well renowned expert in the area. Christine is acting in the form of a critical friend to our Spelling professional learning team to support them through their inquiry.

Our Athletics Carnival is scheduled for Thursday May 6th. This year we will be holding the carnival at Cook Oval. We have our fingers crossed for great weather, but please be mindful of the conditions when you are assisting your child prepare for the day.
