Learn to be a chess champion! Coaching for students at Hawker School (ACT) is held on:

Intermediate: Wednesdays from 7:50am to 9:00am in the Hall, starting 3rd February 2021

Beginner/Rookie: Wednesdays from 7:50am to 9:00am in the Library, starting 3rd February 2021

Learning and playing chess helps children develop their logical thinking and problem solving skills, improves their concentration and focus and is also a great source of enjoyment.

Activities include group lessons on a demonstration chess board or interactive whiteboard, puzzle solving and fun practice games.

Students earn merit awards by making checkmates or by displaying skills and positive qualities, which all good chess players strive to develop.

Music and Drama Scheme 2021



The Hawker School P&C Music and Drama Scheme is a practical way to build your child's skills and confidence with school-based tuition in piano, violin, guitar, drama and choir.

The scheme is open to students enrolled at Hawker School (generally from Year 2 and above) and aims to make extracurricular arts education affordable and easy for families. Individual music lessons and group guitar lessons are held during school times, in close consultation with the school.

The Drama program is run on Tuesday afternoons between 3-4pm and the Choir (Hawker Harmonists) is a non-auditioned choir for students from Years 3-6 held on Friday mornings between 8-8:45am.

With tutor and actor Ruth Pieloop, Drama students learn Improv skills, Drama games, acting exercises, rehearsal techniques and basic stage-craft. Participants develop self-confidence in a safe, fun and supportive environment that builds empathy, strengthens social connections, encourages collaboration, enables group discussion, develops collective problem-solving skills, and exercises the imagination.

Choir

Guitar

Group guitar classes with experienced musician and teacher Marciano Telese encourage students to experience the joy of music and work together with others in a group environment.

Piano and Violin

Piano and Violin lessons aim to inspire students with a love of music and strong technical foundation.

Experienced piano teachers Bethany Roberts, Geoffrey Warren and Arianne Tan are all passionate about sharing their knowledge and love of music with Hawker School students. Arianne Tan is also the violin teacher and as a passionate music educator collaborates with many schools across the ACT.

Book Club



We are looking forward to another great year of the Scholastic Book Club. Book Club provides a fun and convenient way of bringing the best in children's literature into your home. It's packed full of exciting books from best-selling authors, popular titles and series that kids love, as well as products and books that make perfect gifts for family and friends.

It is a very popular program amongst students and parents alike. Over \$6000 worth of items were ordered in 2020, which earned our school library an amazing \$1250 reward dollars to spend. Supporting this program not only helps your child's reading but contributes to re-sourcing the library and classrooms.

Ordering is easy with an Online system called "LOOP" found at <https://mybookclubs.scholastic.com.au/parent/login.aspx>. Using this system eliminates the need to return anything to school. Over 80% of our school orders are now being done online which is fantastic, but cash orders are always welcome too!

Remember that if you make a payment by *phone* or are *paying by cash* you need to return your paper order form with either the payment receipt number or cash to the school.

Online ordering of Gifts - If your order is a gift, please tick the "**gift**" option when ordering through LOOP, or write "**OFFICE**" as the class on paper forms. This way your order will not get bundled with your child's class and spoil the surprise. Our lovely office ladies Linda, Renai and Lisa will contact you to come and collect it from the office.
