



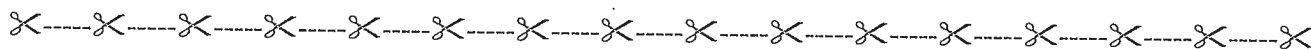

Footsteps Dance Program for Years 1-5

Dear Parents and Carers,

Earlier this term the Footsteps Dance Company provided complimentary dance instruction sessions for several year groups. We received positive feedback about these sessions from students and staff and have booked the Footsteps Dance team for weekly sessions in Term 4 for students in Years 1-5. This program is aligned with the Australian Arts Curriculum and links with our current teaching programs. Each session will include a specific teaching focus such as the development of dance elements, choreography and performance skills, as well as storytelling through dance, cultural appreciation and developing a growth mindset.

The program costs \$28 per student for the duration. This cost includes ten 40-minute dance instruction sessions with a qualified dance instructor from Footsteps Dance Company. We are subsidizing this program, using funds from our Arts budget which will reduce the cost to \$20 per student for the term.
